<u>Legos – Jedi Engineering</u> – Grades K – 2, Mondays, 3:15pm - 4:45pm at the Elmer-Thienes Elementary School Steam Room. Cost is \$117.00 for residents and \$127.00 for non-residents. This is a 6 week class January  $25^{th}$  - February  $29^{th}$ .

<u>Parents Night Out</u> – Grades 1 – 8, Saturday, December 19<sup>th</sup>, 6:00pm – 9:00pm at the Elmer – Thienes Elementary School Community Room. Drop off the kids and enjoy an evening out at a movie, dinner or shopping for a few hours. Kids will have the option of participating in arts and crafts activities, games, sports or watching a movie. Pizza and beverages will be provided. Cost for this program is \$12.00 per child resident/\$15.00 per child non-resident.

<u>Music Lessons</u> – Grades 4 – 8, at the Elmer-Thienes Elementary School Media Room. Private lesson instruction on band instruments will be provided by Bruce Foote. This is a six week session beginning on January 7<sup>th</sup>. The lessons are a half hour in length and will occur on the same day and time signed up for. The fee includes lesson materials and one make-up lesson is guaranteed during the six week series. Time slots will run for a half hour from 3:10 to 5:10 on Thursdays and 3:10 to 6:10 on Fridays. Fee is \$103.00 for residents/\$113.00 for non-residents.

<u>December Vacation Camp</u> – Grades 1 – 6, December 28<sup>th</sup> – December 30<sup>th</sup>, 8:00am – 3:00pm, at the Elmer Thienes Mary Hall Elementary School. Children will enjoy 3 days of activities, games, sports, arts, crafts and movie time. Children will be broken up into groups determined by their grade. Vacation camp will be overseen by the Parks and Recreation Director and recreation day camp staff. This program will be held in the community room and cafeteria. Participants can sign up for one or multiple days at the camp. Fee is \$45.00 per day resident/\$50.00 non-resident.

<u>Babysitting Course</u> - Students in Grade 6 only – Wednesdays, January 13<sup>th</sup> – February 17<sup>th</sup>, 5:00-6:30pm in the Elmer Thienes Mary Hall Elementary School cafeteria. \$73 for residents/\$76.00 for non-residents. ONLY 25 Slots and always fills up – so register early. Attendance mandatory, only 1 absence allowed. Graduation is held on the last day of class.

<u>Safe Home Alone Readiness Program</u> - Ages 10 and up – Thursdays, March 3<sup>rd</sup> – March 17<sup>th</sup> at the Elmer Thienes Mary Hall School. Through role-playing and hands-on activities, children will learn basic safety information vital to being home alone. The first two classes will be held from 5pm to 6:30pm and the graduation ceremony on the last day will be held from 5pm to 6pm. At least one parent is required to attend the graduation. Fee for this program is \$43.00 residents/\$48.00 non-resident.
