Youth Programs – Art/Crafts

Acrylic Painting on Canvas - Grades 3-6, Elmer Thienes – Mary Hall Elementary School Art Room – Wednesdays, 3:30 – 5:00pm, October 10th – October 31st. Students will learn painting techniques such as layering, color blending and creating realistic textures and shading. During each class students will be guided to complete a landscape of their choice. Students are encouraged to bring a snack. Fee is \$80 for residents/\$85 for non-residents.

Artventures in the Rainforest – Grades K-4, at Elmer Thienes – Mary Hall Elementary School Cafeteria. Mondays, 5:30 – 6:30pm, October 22nd – December 17th. Head off on a jungle art safari. Build rockin rain sticks, design metal art reptiles, and create colorful backpacks. Throughout the voyage art adventurers learn about the importance of saving the rainforest, and pick up super artist survival skills like sculpting with clay, printmaking, painting, collage, and journaling.
