# Youth Programs – Art/Crafts

<u>Acrylic Painting on Canvas</u> - Grades 3-6, Elmer Thienes – Mary Hall Elementary School Art Room – Wednesdays, 3:30 – 5:00pm, October 10<sup>th</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>.
